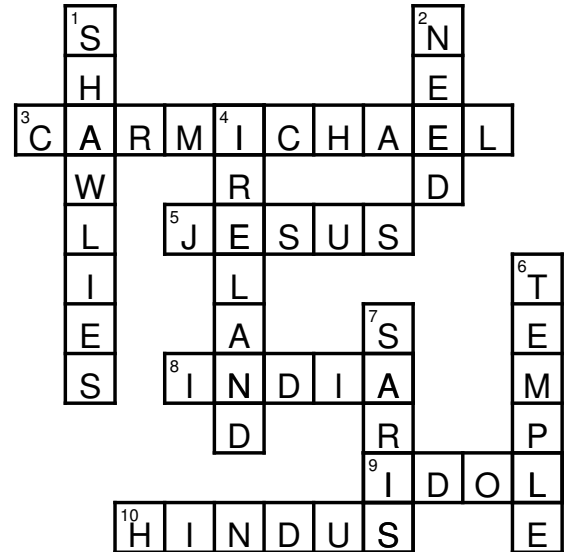

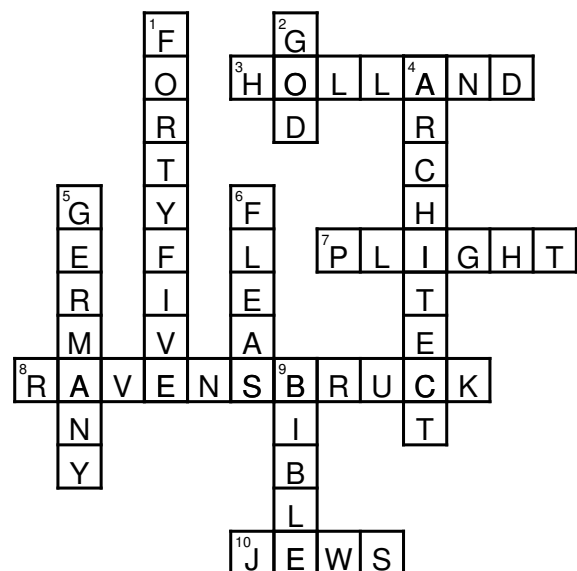

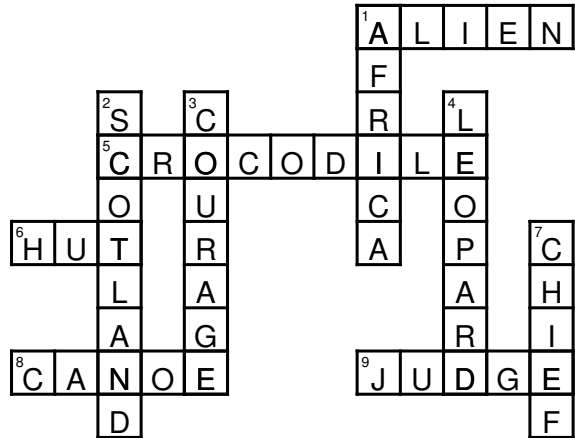
### Mary Slessor Quiz: Correct Facts
